

# Vote in Person

**San Diego County Registrar estimates 600,000 (42%) of the ballots cast in 2020 were “re-made” by the seasonal workers**

**Any ballot returned in a Mail-in ballot envelope is “reviewed” by unsupervised or “watched” Seasonal employees who have sole discretion to “re-make” ballots. Which is also done without any supervision or oversight**

**600,000 votes are enough to change an election**

**The only type of ballot that goes from the voter directly to counting are those votes that are cast in person**

**Seasonal employees do not have to be US Citizens, are not required to take an oath or held to the same standards and laws as US Citizens**

**Re-Making a Ballot is the transfer of a vote from an original “bad” ballot to a new ballot**
