Vote in Person

San Diego County Registrar estimates 600,000 (42%) of the ballots cast in 2020 were "re-made" by the seasonal workers

Any ballot returned in a Mail-in ballot envelope is "reviewed" by unsupervised or "watched" Seasonal employees who have sole discretion to "re-make" ballots. Which is also done without any supervision or oversight

600,000 votes are enough to change an election

The only type of ballot that goes from the voter directly to counting are those votes that are cast in person

Seasonal employees do not have to be US Citizens, are not required to take an oath or held to the same standards and laws as US Citizens

Re-Making a Ballot is the transfer of a vote from an original "bad" ballot to a new ballot
