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Petitioners Orrin E. Heatlie and California Patriot Coalition – Recall Governor Gavin Newsom, and Respondent Secretary of State Alex Padilla, through their counsel of record, agree and stipulate to the following:

- 1. On November 17, 2020, this Court entered judgment extending the November 17, 2020 deadline for Petitioners to submit recall petitions to elections officials to March 17, 2021. The Court retained jurisdiction to allow the parties to seek "additional relief should circumstances warrant such relief."
- 2. Under California law, recall proponents are only permitted to circulate and file petitions in the form approved by the Secretary of State. Recall petitions have three sections: (1) the heading, which includes the recall request, notice of intention to recall and statement of reasons, and the official's answer; (2) signature space; and (3) a declaration of circulator verifying their signature-gathering efforts under penalty of perjury. As relevant here, the declaration requires the circulator to set forth the dates between which all signatures to the petition were obtained, and includes the circulator's certification under penalty of perjury stating the date and place of execution. Elec. Code § 11046; Elec. Code § 104.
- 3. On June 10, 2020, the Secretary of State approved a petition seeking to recall Governor Gavin Newsom for circulation (the "Original Petition"). Because the original circulation period ran from June 10, 2020 through November 17, 2020, the declaration of circulator on the Original Petition specifies the year "2020" for the signature-gathering dates and on the certification:

4. Because the signature-gathering period will now extend into 2021, Petitioners have requested that Respondent approve a second petition that specifies the year "2021" in the declaration of circulator (the "Alternative Petition"). A true and correct copy of the form of

Alternative Petition is attached as Exhibit 1 (including both the five-line version and the 10-line version). The Alternative Petition does not make any changes except to replace the year "2020" with the year "2021" in the three places noted above.

- 5. Respondent does not object to the use of the Alternative Petition, but contends that there is no explicit statutory authorization for the Secretary of State to approve multiple petitions for circulation.
- 6. The parties request that the Court amend the November 17, 2020 judgment to permit Petitioners to collect signatures using either the Original Petition or the Alternative Petition.

The Court continues to retain jurisdiction over this matter to allow any party to seek additional relief should circumstances warrant such relief.
